

Guidelines for the Doctoral Colloquium Presenters - 3rd IRCE

Dear Presenter,

We gratefully acknowledge your contribution to the 3rd International Research Conference on Education. To ensure the effectiveness and timely conduct of the technical session, we request your adherence to the following presentation guidelines.

1. Presentation Duration

Each paper presentation is allocated a total of **25 minutes**, distributed as follows:

- **Presentation:** 12 to 15 minutes
- **Discussion:** 10 to 13 minutes

Session chairs will notify you when your presentation time is nearing its conclusion. Presenters are kindly requested to adhere to these time limits to maintain the conference schedule.

2. Suggested Presentation Structure

To assist in organizing your presentation, the following sections are recommended where applicable:

1. Title (Title of the Study, Author(s)' name(s), and Paper ID only)
Note: The Title of the Study and the Author(s)' name(s) must be as in the manuscript. Don't use titles such as Prof, Dr, Mr, Before the author names.
2. Introduction of the Study/ Background of the Study
3. Literature Review and Research Problem/ Establishment of Research Gap
4. Aim and Objectives/ Aim and Research Questions/ Aim and Hypotheses
5. Methodology (Research Approach, Research Design, Population, Sampling, Sample Size, Data Collection, and Data Analysis)
6. Results/ Findings, and Discussions
7. Conclusion, and Recommendations / Conclusion, and Implications
8. Recommendations for Further Research
9. References (Maximum of 5, key citations only)

Note: The order listed above is a general guideline, not a mandatory sequence. Presenters may adapt the structure to best fit their research design, disciplinary conventions, and presentation style. The primary consideration is clarity and logical flow for the audience.

3. Slide Limit

To ensure effective time management and audience engagement, the total number of slides **should not exceed 10** (including the title slide and references). Presenters are encouraged to focus on key messages rather than reproducing the extended abstract content.

4. Font Specifications

To ensure consistent display across all systems, please adhere to the following font guidelines:

- **For English Text:** Times New Roman
- **For Tamil Text:** Bamini

5. Slide Design and Visual Guidelines

To maintain a professional and readable presentation, please observe the following design standards:

- Title Font Size: 32–40 pt
- Content Font Size: 24–28 pt
- Use high-contrast colour schemes for optimal readability.
- Present content in concise points rather than lengthy paragraphs.
- Incorporate graphs, charts, tables, and figures to enhance clarity and impact.
- Don't use animations, transitions, or multimedia effects.

6. Presentation File Submission
